

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INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS

1. Parents Teacher Meeting is compulsory to all parents.
2. Leave will be sanctioned only on medical ground with prior intimation of the school
3. All dues should be cleared before (a) 28 *feb for class Nursery to 9th and Class 11th. (b) 31 January for Class 10th and 12th.
4. Apply for T.C. within 15 days of declaration of result. If application is placed after 15 days then the whole annual charge and 1st installment must be paid, only then T.C. will be issued.
5. Registration for admission is to be done at the time notified every year. Registration is no guarantee for admission.
6. At the time of admission an attested photocopy of the Birth Certificate should be submitted.
7. Admission to students who have attended other school is granted only if they have produced a transfer certificate from the previous school.
8. T.C. from outside the state Board is not acceptable unless counter signed by the competent authority.
9. A meeting of the student along with the parents is required prior to the admission.
10. Parents/ Guardian should ensure to fill the correct Date of Birth and other details in the admission form. No subsequent change will be permitted for any condition.
11. The management reserves to itself the right to admit or refuse student seeking admission to the school giving admission.
12. A written application is required before withdrawing a student from the school, clearance certificate must be attached with the application form.
13. The transfer certificate of a student is issued only when all the school dues have been cleared.
14. A week's time is to be given for issuing any certificate or document from the school.
15. Student discontinuing in the middle of the term shall pay fees entire term.
16. Duplicate T.C. will be issued on payment of Rs. 500.
17. No pass Certificate will be issued to any student who leaves the institution before the end of the session. The Principal may request the parents to withdraw a student who in case does not fit in with regulation of the school or is not capable of any improvement or if the parents themselves do not cooperate with school authority.
18. Promotion is granted on the basis of whole year performance.
19. Under no circumstances will an examination be taken either before or after the scheduled time.



20. A Student may be exempted on medical ground from one periodical test Only. Appearing in the final examination is compulsory for promotion.
21. Parents are requested to examine the marks record of their wards carefully
22. Signature found in the marks record or progress report should be identical with the specimen signature found in the diary. Those who lose or damage the progress report shall pay a fine of Rs. 100
23. If any student fails regularly to reach the minimum marks for pass in any subject any concession that he/she enjoys is cancelled.
24. The evaluation of the answer script & other work done by the student, during an examination are within the jurisdiction of the school & therefore outside persons or authority has no jurisdiction to check scrutinize or claim back' answer script or any work done by the student
25. If in the opinion of the principal & class teacher the result is significantly below the standard and suggested by the student class work then a query of the grade awarded may be checked by the teacher appointed by principal
26. School fees will be charged for the whole session. No allowance in fees is made for broken periods. The details of the fees will be given to your wards at the beginning of the academic year
27. Parents will kindly keep the receipts issued to them in proof payment of fees to be produced when needed.
28. All the school dues must be cleared before the beginning of every examination, failing which a student will not be permitted to give the examination
29. Once the management fees has been paid will not refunded even if the student is withdrawn
30. Result will not be given to the student who fails to clear the school dues.
31. The school reserves to itself the right to dismiss student whose diligence or progress in studies is unsatisfactory or whose conduct is harmful to other student or whose parents or guardians show little interest in the progress of their wards.
32. Immorality grave in subordination contempt of authority or will full damage to property is always a sufficient damage for immediate dismissal.
33. No student is permitted to engage any of the school teachers as private tutors without the written sanction of the management. The management reserves the right to ban the tuition entirely.
34. 500/- Rs Will be charged for rechecking of Annual Examination answer sheets of each subject.



35. Fees will have to be submitted from 1st to 15th day of every month. Failure of submission will lead to impose a fine of Rs. 100/- in the fees of that month. Failure in the deposition of fees in the next month will increase to Rs. 200/- fine in the fees. A fine of Rs. 500/- will be charged as a late fee on the 1st month and the name will be struck off.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS

1. 85% Attendance is compulsory.
2. Appearance in all examination is compulsory.
3. Active participation in Co-Curricular activity is compulsory.
4. Warning letters will be issued against in-disciplinary work.
5. T.C. will be issued with 3 warning letter.
6. Proper dress code should be followed.
 - A. Wednesday- white shirt and trousers with school shoes and socks.
 - B. Saturday- House Track Suit for both boys and girls.
 - C. Rest days- **(For Boys)** Mustard Trousers and white shirt with black school shoes socks and belt.

For Girls- Mustard skirt and white shirt (up to 5th), White Salwar and Mustard Kurta and mustard Waistcoat (from onward) with black school shoes and socks and belt.

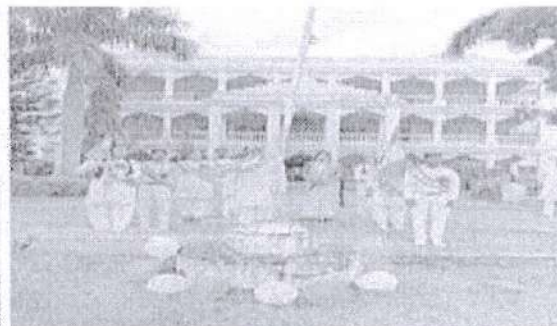
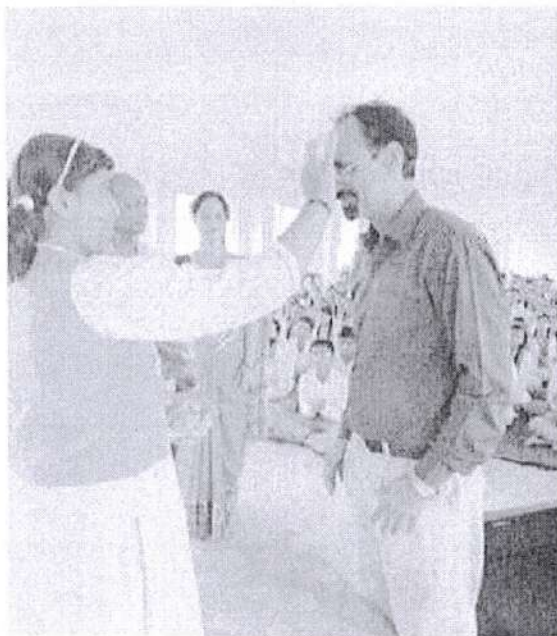

7. Halfday leave will not be allowed to students.
8. Consistent neglect of any subject will not be condemned.
9. Absence in the examination will be treated as having received no marks in it.
10. In view of the system of continued assessment of the student and of the fact that the year's average is taken for promotion. The result declared at the end of the year is final and cannot be reconsidered. In all matters of promotion or failure the principal's decision is final. Answer script of final examination shall not be shown.
11. A student who uses unfair means/ receives or gives assistance in any form during a test; public examination shall be given zero marks in the subjects. Repetition of the same will result in dismissal.
12. As per the directive of the CBSE Central Board of Secondary Education a student with less than 85% attendance at the end of the session will be prevented from appearing in the final/board examination.
13. Student should attend the school regularly they must reach school before the assembly. Any student failing to attend the assembly will be consider absent, for the day, late comers as well as those who have been absent must gave' their regularity record duly signed. Habitual late coming or coming 10 school in improper/incomplete uni form is inclusive of being send back home and on such occasion the school declines al V responsibility for their returns.

14. Students are not allowed to bring noobile, ipocls, music system or large amount of money to school. If such items are found, it will be returned only after the session is over.
15. Parents are instructed to give pen, pencil or an eraser (value not more than 10 Rs.) may be given instead of toffees and éclairs on their wards birthday.
16. In case your child is unwell and not fit to come for the class test, please send a leave note with Medical Certificate for follow up within 2 days of rejoining.
17. Any change in the residential address, telephone no., mobile No. and other details given at the time of admission/Mid- session should be intimated by written application to class teacher. This is very important for your child's security.
18. Examination of class XI will be conducted in the month of February. Class XII study will start from 1st March.
19. The following are not permitted on school with no exceptions hair coloring, penning, mehndi, nail polish, body tattoos, kajal, eyeliner, perfumes, deodorant, hair gel, bangles, expensive watches, fancy accessories, fancy hair cutting etc.
20. Chewing gum 'pan masala' or any other form of addiction irregular attendance, disobedience, misconduct, any form of verbal, written demonstration of obscenity, using unfair means in exam, damage to school's or other's property, use of foul language, causing physical harm to others, bullying rowdiness, misconduct in the school bus etc. will leave to stern disciplinary action, repeated misconduct may call for suspension from school.
21. It is mandatory for each and every student to bring the school calendar, school diary and wear the ID card to school daily.

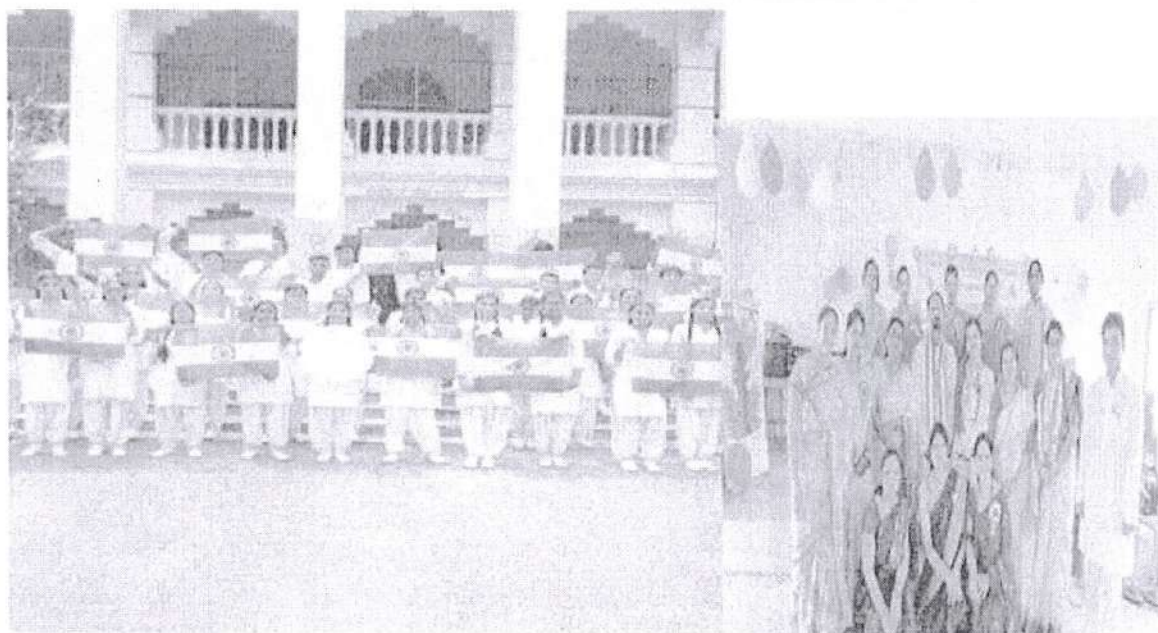
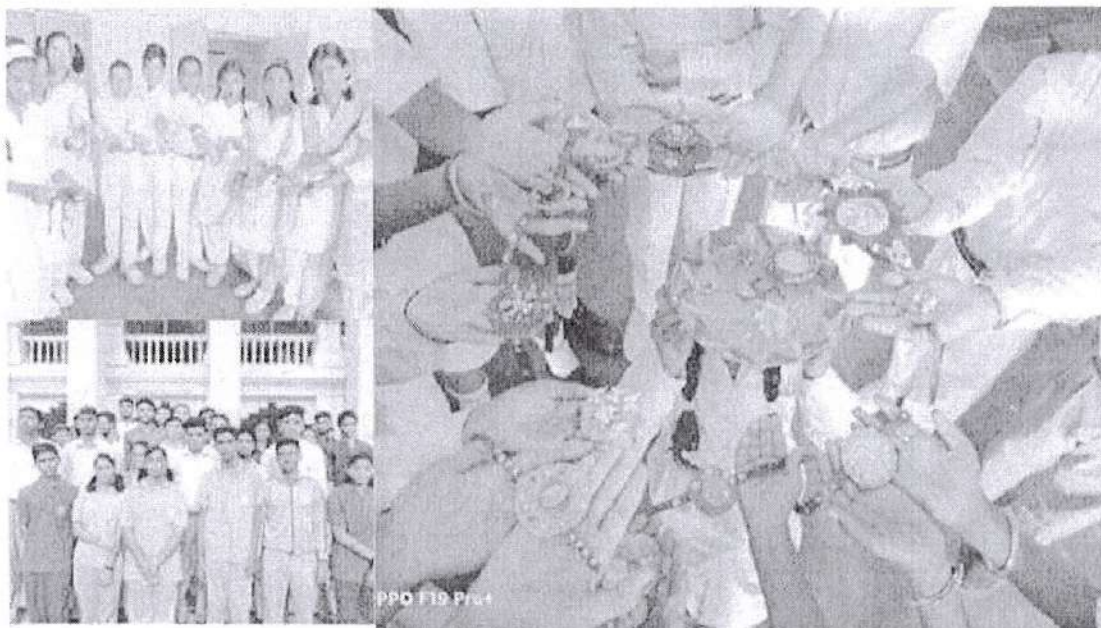


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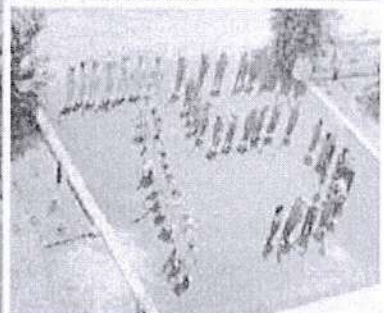
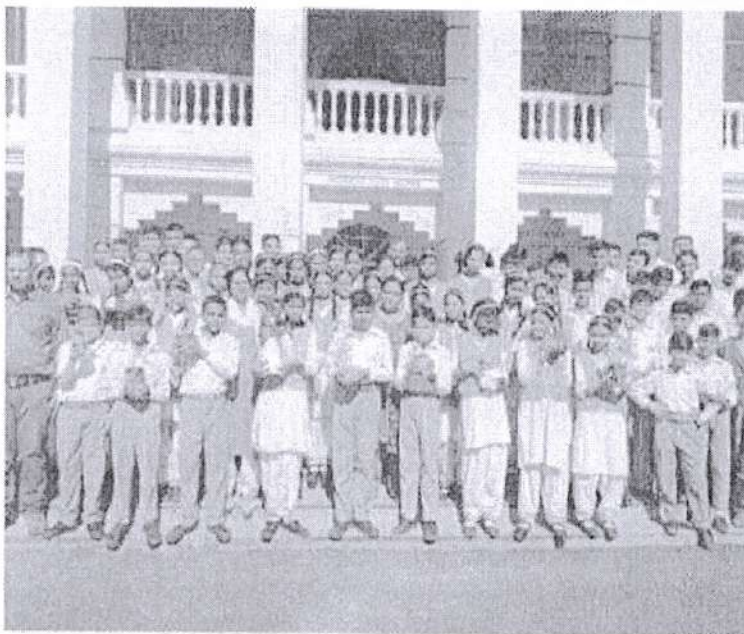
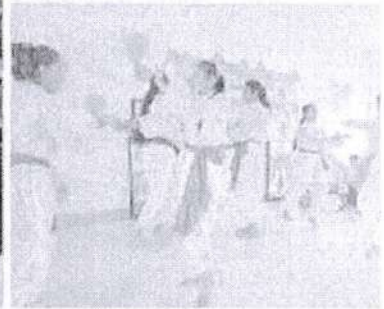
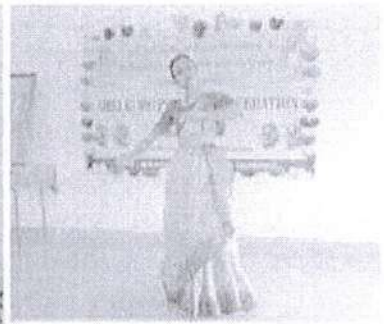
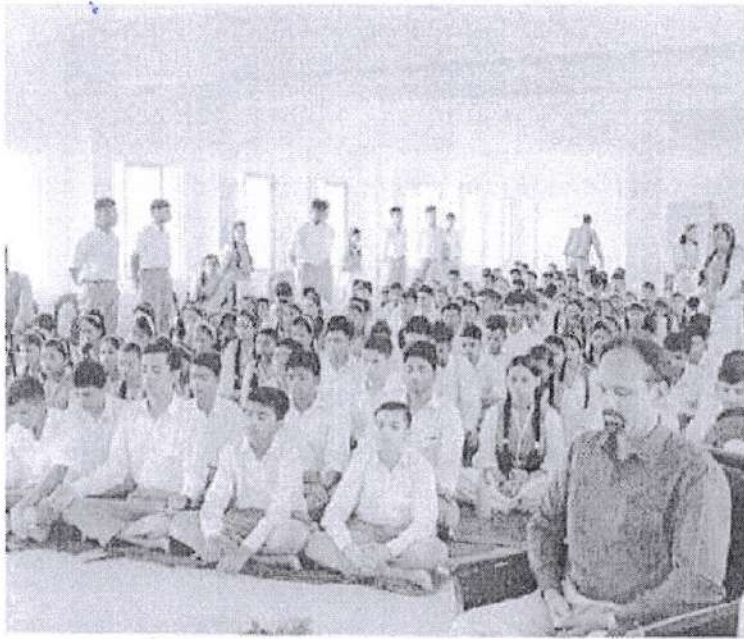
